

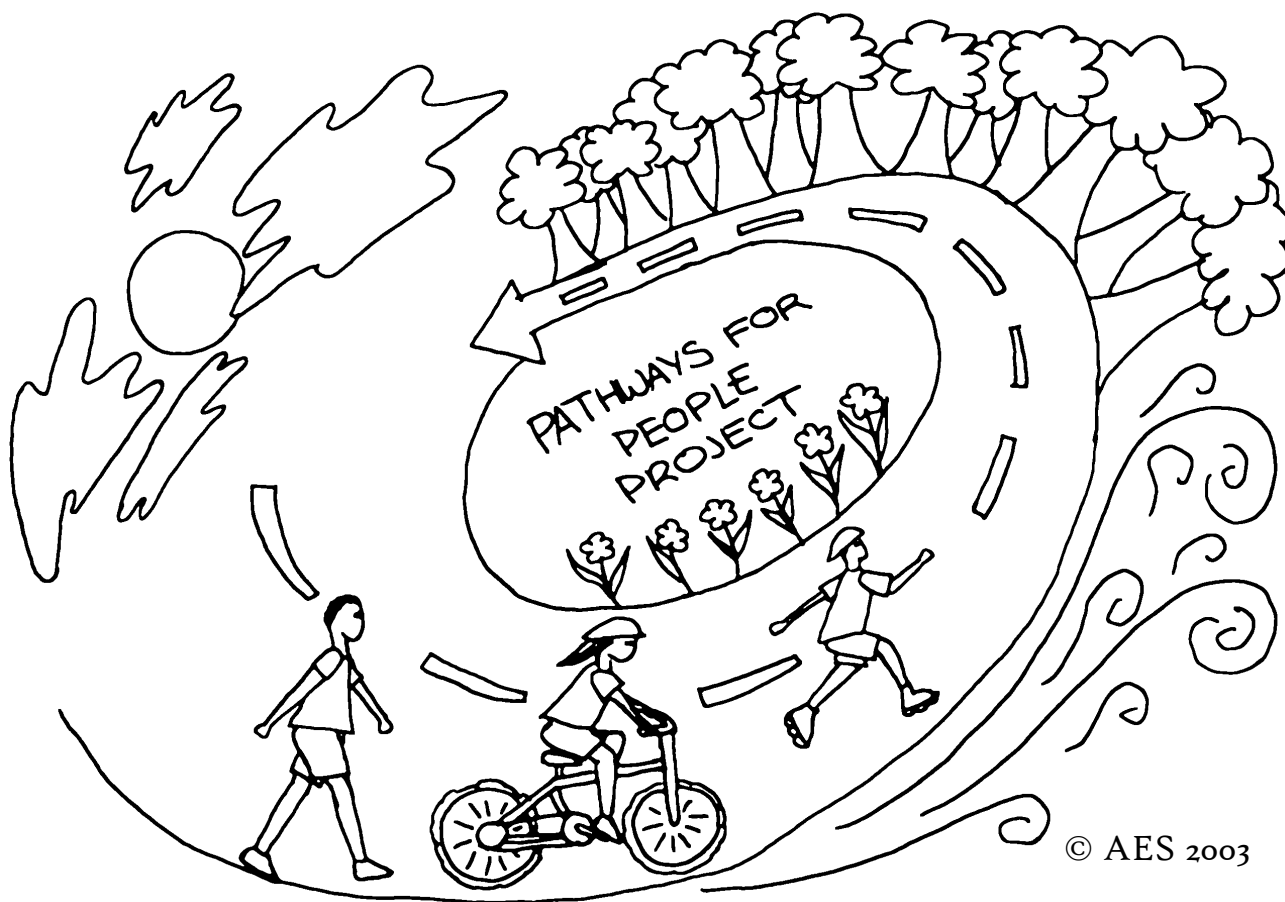
Pathways for People Project
